Brunello di Montalcino and Brunello di Montalcino Riserva: 2018, 2017 and Other Recent Releases, Part 2

San Guglielmo 2018 Brunello di Montalcino 94

Bright dark red. Very perfumed, with minerals, pomegranate, sour red cherry, and roses on the knockout nose. Then beautifully delineated and pure, with lifted flavours of red fruits. Minerals and blood orange repeat and linger on the silky, vibrant and laser-like finish. This is not the last word in complexity and its sensory profile has more in common with an outstanding wine from Radda than it does of Montalcino, but it really is an outstanding Sangiovese wine. Really well done: I'm impressed. Drinking window: 2027-2036.
